Football, Mindy reporting

- Getting ready for the season. Evaluations will take place in August.
- Elections were held: Mindy was elected President, Wes Bailey VP.

Softball

- They have 90 Rebel players on tournament teams. Each team does their own fundraising.
- They have 40 Wildcats player to play rec (so far). March 4<sup>th</sup> will be tryouts at the High School.
- They are working on improving the fields at Baker Prairie
- They did not host the Super Bowl Breakfast this year.
- They will be hosting two 12U, two 10U and one 14U tournaments.

Baseball

- Tryouts will be next weekend. Practices will start March 13<sup>th</sup>.
- They hope to have 3 Senior teams, 4 Midget and 4 Junior teams.
- With a month to go for signups, so far, they have 48 T-Ball players signed up (last year they had 60 players).

- They had board elections and the board stayed the same.
- They hope to use Baker Prairie for practices. Poor drainage continues to be an issue.
- They will be hosting 9 tournaments at various levels.
- Senior Federal has lengthened the travel distance between teams.

#### Lacrosse

- They are down 34 players from last year. One team for grade 3/4, 2 teams for grade 5/6 and three teams for grade 7/8 grade teams.
- March 16 will be evaluation for team placement.
- There is a new head coach at the high school.

#### Soccer

- They are down 25 kids so far for spring rec and have formed 11 teams to play in WYSA.
- Valley River Soccer continues to use Canby fields without going through proper channels.
